



## **CREATING NEW HISTORY**

This residential pocket of Capitol Hill is a dynamic and affluent area filled with eclectic dining options, trendy retail shops and eye-catching architecture that evokes a warm and welcoming sense of community amongst locals and visitors strolling the streets. Once home to a brewery, ice cream factory and beloved amusement park, Beckert's Park is being reimagined to match this idyllic urban neighborhood and vibrant history. On the corner of 14th Street and Kentucky Avenue Southeast, the 2.75-acre Beckert's Park site is redeveloping into a 325-unit Class-A apartment project with a new 60,000-square-foot Safeway and up to 8,000 square feet of neighborhood retail space just two blocks from the Potomac Avenue Metro.





Capitol Hill is one of the nation's most well-known neighborhoods, recognized for its historic Neoclassical architecture, iconic government institutions such as the Capitol, the Senate and House buildings, the Supreme Court and the Library of Congress. Beyond these formative pillars, Capitol Hill is an idyllic tight-knit residential community for well-heeled 30-something intellectuals in public administration, business, finance, lobbying and computer occupations. While a calm and safe neighborhood to live and work, Capitol Hill falls short on leisure opportunities, forcing residents and employees to venture into other district neighborhoods for nightlife and recreation options. Tapping into this underserved entertainment zone, Beckert's Park is creating new history with a playful and engaging vision for the masses to converge.
