

ATWORTH



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- Construction is currently ongoing to build 451 apartment units and approximately 5,000 SF of retail with availability Q4 of 2023.
- The subject site is in close proximity to the University of Maryland, College Park, with over 40,000 students.
- The development sits on a former WMATA surface lot, immediately adjacent to the College Park green, yellow, and future purple line stations.
 The College Park-University of Maryland Station also serves Marc's Camden line (the 39mi line that runs between Union Station, Washington D.C. and Camden Station, Baltimore Maryland).

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This transit-oriented development is located on a 6.4-acre site adjacent to the College Park Metro stop and the future Purple Line. The site is less than one mile from the University of Maryland and within walking distance of Whole Foods, hiking and biking trails, and other desirable amenities. The 5,000 SF of ground floor retail space is ideal for regional and local food uses, as well as entertainment uses, given the proximity to the university.


